Proposed Modifications to a project in the 2011 Transportation Conformity

To allow IH 35E improvements in Denton County to move closer to construction, staff will discuss a proposed change to staging for this project listed in the 2011 Transportation Conformity analysis, which documents that the total ozone-causing pollution expected from all the region's planned transportation projects are within limits established in the State Implementation Plan. The air quality analysis incorporates, among many factors, the expected completion date of transportation projects. IH 35E improvements in Denton County are expected to move to construction, and ultimately completion, sooner than initially outlined in 2011 Transportation Conformity. Therefore, staff is re-evaluating elements of the air quality analysis to ensure the transportation-air quality balance continues to meet air quality regulations. Staff will summarize proposed changes to the analysis and draft results.

Comments on the proposed changes are due by August 8, 2012.
